Walking Bus

Our Walking Bus is proving to be popular – thank you to parents volunteering to help out with this (we are collecting names at the moment). So that we can make the Bus as efficient as possible, we will be setting off at **8.45am** each day after Easter, instead of 8.50am. If you have not yet signed up for the Bus, but would like to, please see Mrs Hitchin.

Sharing a Love of Reading

Have you got books at home which your children have read and loved but are now ready to part with? We are starting up a Book Swap Box after Easter and would love for you and your child to help us out with this initiative. The Book Swap Box contains donated books which are used but in **good condition and clean of any writing**. Children bring one book and swap it for another. This might be an old favourite which your child is keen to share and does not mind donating to the Box. Your child should bring along one book only at a time and swap it for one book only. They can keep bringing and swapping as long as they like, enjoying the books others are keen to share. If they look after the books they borrow too, then they should last for a few cycles.

Your child will find the Book Swap Box in school after Easter – they should feel free to help themselves, but they should donate one to take one. Please check that your book is clean, free of writing or names and appropriate for a reader of between 4 and 6 years of age. If you are not sure, please do just ask. We will check the book box to make sure the books are suitable too.

With reading in mind, at Hunsley Primary we are certainly biased towards thinking that a good book is one of the great joys of life! To be good Reading Role Models, we will be sharing some of our own childhood reads after Easter in our Match the Teacher to the Text quiz. For fun, see how many members of staff your child can match to the correct favourite childhood book: I wonder how many they will get!?

Reception – National Child Measurement Programme

The school nursing team will be visiting Hunsley Primary this week to measure the height and weight of the children in Reception as part of the National Child Measurement programme. Parents/Carers will receive their child's results by post within six weeks of their child being measured.

Uniform

A quick reminder for parents planning on buying new uniform over the holiday: we are no longer using indoor shoes in Year 1. On a rainy day, if your child comes to school in wellingtons, please make sure they have a pair of plain, black outdoor school shoes to change into. Your child should not be wearing boots in school, either in Year 1 or Reception.

Shirts should be a plain, white **polo-shirt** style and not a stiff collar, cotton button-down style – please make sure you are purchasing the style of shirt stated in the uniform policy (if you are not sure, please do ask). Polo shirts with fewer buttons also facilitate children getting themselves changed for PE more effectively and independently. You can buy multi-pack plain versions of these at most supermarkets (or you can purchase the school logo shirt from the office, if you prefer).
