School Trips

Walking Bus

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, commencing this week, we will be setting off at **8.45am** each day, instead of 8.50am. If you have not yet signed up for the Bus, but would like to, please see Mrs Hitchin.

Pupil Premium Grant

Claiming pupil premium funding for your children gives the school an additional £1320 a year known as the Pupil Premium Grant. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive a free school meal regardless of the family income, but not all children will be eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant.

To qualify for the Pupil Premium Grant you must fulfil one of the following criteria;

- Job Seekers Allowance (Income Based)
- Income Support
- Child Tax Credit (<u>but NOT receiving Working Tax Credit</u>) provided your annual income, assessed by the Inland Revenue, does not exceed £16,190 (Please note: The amount is subject to change in April every year).

- Employment Support Allowance (Income Related)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.

To find out if your child is eligible the benefits team at your Local Authority can process your claim by telephone as long as you tell them your name, date of birth. National Insurance Number and the name and date of birth of each child attending school, also which school they attend.

Sharing a Love of Reading

Have you got books at home which your children have read and loved but are now ready to part with? We are starting up a Book Swap Box this term and would love for you and your child to help us out with this initiative. The Book Swap Box contains donated books which are used but in **good condition and clean of any writing**. Children bring one book and swap it for another. This might be an old favourite which your child is keen to share and does not mind donating to the Box. Your child should bring along one book only at a time and swap it for one book only. They can keep bringing and swapping as long as they like, enjoying the books others are keen to share. If they look after the books they borrow too, then they should last for a few cycles.

Your child will find the Book Swap Box in school after Easter – they should feel free to help themselves, but they should donate one to take one. Please check that your book is clean, free of writing or names and appropriate for a reader of between 4 and 6 years of age. If you are not sure, please do just ask. We will check the book box to make sure the books are suitable too.

With reading in mind, at Hunsley Primary we are certainly biased towards thinking that a good book is one of the great joys of life! To be good Reading Role Models, we will be sharing some of our own childhood reads this term in our Match the Teacher to the Text quiz. For fun, see how many members of staff your child can match to the correct favourite childhood book: I wonder how many they will get!?

Hunsley Primary Parent Parking Permit
