World Book Day – 7 March 2019

Pupil Leadership Team – Pupil Voice

The Pupil Leadership Team meets with me fortnightly, and they are always full of good ideas about how to develop the school. Last week, we looked at the kinds of activities the children

would like to have included in the social calendar of the school. The PLT is a great way of getting the children together to share their views, lead on school developments and be more involved in the way our school evolves and grows. Each child will have a chance to be part of the PLT, for example as a representative of their house, class, or as part of a pupil voice panel, where staff will take time to listen to the children's ideas about school initiatives, or perhaps also in connection with sporting, charitable or other extra-curricular activities. It is very important to give children leadership opportunities in school from the outset and last week we also celebrated Sport Leadership, which is why some of the children came home with Sports Leaders' certificates! Well done, everyone, for getting involved and thinking about the bigger team.

PE at Hunsley Primary

As you know, part of the unique partnership between Hunsley Primary and South Hunsley is the way our teaching teams work together to offer the children a really interesting curriculum which leads all the way from Reception to Year 13. PE is no exception and we are still working closely with the PE department to deliver interesting sports experiences for the children from the outset. Miss Hepburn coaches alongside our teaching team and also leads sessions on PE and Dance, which the children thoroughly enjoy. Last half term, we worked with Tiger's Trust and Fit4Fun. Miss Hepburn will be working with the Yorkshire Cricket Board later on this half term. She will also be working closely with Year 2 and 3 on Thursday mornings.

Maths Workshops

Mrs Russell – our Specialist Leader in Maths – continues to work with the team to deliver maths workshops across the school, to ensure that our children's fluency in maths continues to flourish and to support where that little bit of extra help is needed. We are looking forward to Mrs Russell joining us for workshops this half term and to helping the children reach their full potential.

Parental Involvement with Hunsley Primary

Attendance

As of Friday 15 February our overall attendance percentage was **97.2%** with **31** pupils receiving 100% attendance and **100** pupils with attendance over the National Average of 95%.

A quick update on our attendance procedures:

We provide work for children who have missed school through illness. If your child has missed school and you would like to have further home learning activities to help your child catch up, please speak with your class teacher who will be very happy to provide you with additional suggestions and / or resources.

A reminder that all pupils should be in school for the start of the school day and morning registration at 9.00am. School is open from 8.50am. Any child who arrives after 9am will be given a late mark (L) on the register. If a child arrives after 9.30am they will be given a late after registration mark (U) on the register.

If your child is attending an appointment please provide the school with a copy of the appointment letter/card. If your child is poorly please contact the school's absence line on

each day of absence or alternatively you can send an email to absence@hunsleyprimary.org.uk.

Please ensure that upon your child's return the school is also provided with a written reason for absence. This can be done via your child's journal, on a separate note or by using the school's [pupil absence note](#).

Beverley Treasure House, Museum, Gallery and Library Visit – 28 Feb 2019

We are really excited to be taking the children to the museum and gallery on Thursday. We are particularly looking forward to talking to them about the value of art and exhibitions, and to challenging them to think about the relevance of street art and graffiti by artists such as Banksy (who the children are studying) and its place alongside more traditional pieces. There are some fantastic local artefacts and archaeological pieces in the museum too – from Brough, South Cave and other familiar places – so the children will be exploring what gives artefacts value and why we should study them!

Please can all parents note within the public art gallery, there is currently an installation of moving image pieces which have some flickering light effects. The Gallery staff leave it to visitors to decide whether they wish to avoid the flickering lights. **If you would prefer for your child not to visit this part of the exhibition, please could you let school know by the end of the day on Wednesday 27 February.**
