



STAYING SAFE ONLINE

HUNSLEY PRIMARY SafeAPPS

A **Ask** Always ask before you use a device and use it when an **Adult** is nearby. **Don't have too much screen time!**

P **Personal Information** This is **Private** and shouldn't be shared with people you don't know. **Don't share your name, address, school, phone number or places you go.**

P **Photos** These are for your family and friends. Never send a photo of yourself without checking with your **Parents**. **If someone asks for a photo online, tell your grown-up.**

S **Say Something** If something doesn't seem right, don't switch off - **Shout out!** We check what you look for online in school to keep you safe - let your grown-up decide what to do.

Stop **Stop and think before you share!** Your photos, personal information and words will no longer be under your control once you have published them. Don't use other people's ideas, images or words without their permission.

Alert **Are you protecting your passwords?** Be alert about security at all times. Change your passwords regularly and never share them.

Fake **Is it fake or is it real?** News, views and images can all be fake and we need to take time to question it. Don't believe everything you see on screen! Think before you repeat it or try to copy it: is it the truth? Is it real?

Engage **Are you an informed Internet user?** If something worries you, don't ignore it: talk about it! Your teachers monitor what you search for and see online, and our filters keep you safe. Stay engaged: your online safety matters.

We've signed up for Pol-Ed!



Pol-Ed is a completely free PSHE related curriculum which supports schools in delivering expertly-planned lessons designed to develop a deep awareness of risks, citizenship and the law.

Pol-Ed is available to all schools across Hull, East Yorkshire, North and North East Lincolnshire and we have recently attended the regional training briefing to help us in our use of these resources. Parents and Carers can also access information and help on this website.

Inclusion Group Meeting Updates and Feedback!

Thank you to the parents and carers who attended the most recent Inclusion Group catch-up, and thank you to Mrs Liz Russell (our SEND and Inclusion Governor) for attending again and supporting this work too!

It has been a pleasure to listen to parents and carers, both through this group, and through the additional feedback and catch-ups we have had, about the things you find helpful in school and the services you would like to be able to access.

This week, we talked about a wide range of matters, including:

- How to support children in the transition steps from Early Years to school, and from primary to secondary school, in as inclusive a way as possible.
- Our parents fed back on the communications that they find useful and the ways school can develop communications to support inclusion
- We looked at how our developing 'map' of local services and provision could help parents and carers to access the things they need for their families:
 - fun activities,
 - play opportunities,
 - music and sports,
 - social and health support
 - wellbeing and mental health services

These are the things you are broadly saying as a parent / carer body that you would like to be able to provide for your children and know more about (please also see **Feedback in Action** below)

- Home Learning and how the trial in Year 6 with book-based activities is being explored as a response to parent /carer feedback on homework.

Anyone is welcome to join this group – it is an informal and friendly group with a core of regular members, but also an open door for anyone wanting to just drop in and share their ideas. The date of the next catch-up will be confirmed soon.




Pre-loved uniform



OUT-OF-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES / EVENTS / LINKS

This section of our newsletter contains information about out-of-school events, activities and links.

Help Available - Gas & Electric: Unity in Community will be providing vouchers to help towards paying for gas and electricity. To qualify you must pay for your energy through a prepayment meter and have not received energy vouchers from Unity in Community within the past 12 months. This is in response to the ongoing cost of living crisis and beneficiaries can be working, unemployed, self-employed or retired. Forest school 4 week programme run by Fitmums

The Forest Project offers bereavement support in a Forest setting for children from 6–17 years who have experienced the death of someone special to them (programmes are organised in appropriate age ranges). Children can get involved in activities such as den building, camp fire cooking, tool making, tree climbing, forest games and rope work etc. Grief support is built into these activities, aimed at helping children explore their grief and loss. Activities are varied and children have the chance to try many different things to help them as they process their bereavement and connect with others in similar situations. Trained Forest Leaders and Bereavement Support Facilitators lead sessions – all of whom have current DBS checks and have done safeguarding training.

We recommend children attend the session on their own, we hold mobile numbers for emergency contacts whilst the children are in the Forest. There are no facilities for parents to stay and wait other than in their own cars. Staff meet children in the carpark at the farm and return them there at the end of the session. Lunch is provided on the long day session, and snacks on the half day sessions. Children should bring a labelled water bottle to every session and wear outdoor clothing. We have a range of second-hand warm clothing if required.

Toilet facilities are available. Children will get most out of this programme if they attend all 4 sessions. If the dates of this programme do not suit please ask us about future dates via heather@fitmums.org.uk.
