RECEPTION– SEPTEMBER 2026

Your Child's Transition to Hunsley Primary

To ensure a smooth transition to Hunsley Primary, a number of key events will take place between now and your child's first day at school in September. It was lovely to see so many of our new Reception children at our 'Welcome to the Hunsley Family' event at the school and we look forward to seeing them again over the Summer Term.

- **Summer Fayre** – Our Summer Fayre will be taking place on **Saturday 4 July, 10am – 2.30pm**. This is an annual event we hold at the school that is supported by our [Hunsley Primary Parent Partners](#). Further details about this event will be sent out in due course.
- **Reception Induction Afternoon and Meet the Teacher event**
On **Tuesday 14 July** there will be two transition events taking place. Our **Reception intake induction afternoon for your child** to attend will take place at the school from **1.30pm – 3.00pm**. The East pedestrian gate will be opened at 1.25pm and you will be able to make your way around to the Reception classroom to drop off your child. At 2.55pm the gate will be reopened for you to collect your child.

Our **Reception 'Meet the Teacher' Event for parents** will take place in the Reception classroom from **4.00pm – 5.00pm**. The West Pedestrian gate will be open for you to access the school grounds and make your way around to the Reception classroom. **Please note that during this time our wraparound provision may be using the outdoor areas therefore the internal school gates may be closed. If you do open them to gain access to the back of the school, please do close them again after you.**

- **Story Time sessions** – We will soon be arranging our Story Time sessions for our new Reception class to attend. Once we have finalised these dates, we will be in touch to confirm arrangements.
- **Preschool/Home Visits** – Our Reception team will carry out Preschool visits to see the children in their familiar settings. Once we know which Preschool your child attends, we will contact them to arrange these visits. If your child does not attend Preschool or if you would like us to visit your child where they are most 'at home' we can also offer home visits.

SAFEGUARDING AND WELLBEING FOCUS

Next week is Mental Health Awareness Week; it runs from the 11 – 17 May. The Mental Health Foundation lists at Number 1 in its top ten strategies for good mental health 'Plan something to look forward to'. This is a really good piece of advice as planning something to look forward to helps us to maintain hope and engagement. **It can be something small, like planning a cup of coffee at the end of the morning, to something greater, such as a weekend activity, a phone call to a loved one or a nice meal.**

This week, why not help your child develop resilience by encouraging them to focus on something to look forward to, perhaps engaging them to help plan it too. We'd love to hear about the things they are looking forward to!

Hotter weather

On the hottest days, please make sure your child comes to school in appropriate sunscreen and a sun-hat. They can wear their PE kits on the hottest days; on other days just a polo shirt and shorts / skirt will be fine – jumpers and cardigans not required. We will always monitor the weather too, and

shall avoid keeping the children out for long periods of time when the sun is high and hot. Don't forget a water bottle – small bottles, please, which we can then refill.

We will enjoy our SATS breakfasts together this week, and we encourage each child to get good rest, good food and to talk about their learning with their families each day, and most of all that they maintain their usual positive and enthusiastic outlook, as ever! East Riding Schools' Music service (ERSMS) Tuition 2026-27

We would like to ensure that the current attendees and the expression of interest list for the ERSMS tuition remains up to date, so that we can allocate children to next academic years groupings accordingly.



We recently sent an email to the parents/carers of the children who currently attend the tuition. Thank you for completing the form to confirm whether your child would like to continue with the tuition.

If your child currently attends tuition, and you have not given notice for them to withdraw, then they will continue in September.

The tuition takes place during the school day and is taught by ERSMS specialist tutors for the following instruments:

- Guitar
- Keyboard/Piano
- Violin/Viola
- Brass

How do I express my child's interest?

If you have not yet expressed your child's interest and you would like to do so, please complete this online form– <https://forms.gle/ECMkvmcvjwkPxWje8>

Please note that movement in these sessions is small and it may not be possible to allocate a place to all the children on the list. When spaces do become available, they will be allocated in order of expression of interest.

How much does the tuition cost?

This academic year the annual cost for parents/carers was £145.50. This price may be subject to change for next academic year as the price charged is worked out on the cost of the provision from the ERSMS and the number of children attending. We will therefore be able to notify parents/carers once the ERSMS have confirmed their charges and the groupings for the Academic Year 2026-27 have been finalised. A music agreement letter with further details about the tuition and costs will be sent to parents/carers before the summer holidays.

How do I confirm that my child will be attending the tuition?

Wait for the school to send you the music agreement letter – this will contain a link that you must complete to confirm your acceptance of the agreement.

You will also receive a letter from the ERSMS – this will contain details about the provision, the specialist tutor and a ERSMS registration link that you must follow to complete your child's registration.

You **MUST** complete both online forms for your child to commence their tuition.

If I accept the music agreement – can I cancel the tuition at a later date?

We advise parents/carers to take into consideration the following cancellation policy before accepting the music agreement and completing the ERSMS registration form.

If you decide later in the year to cancel your child's music tuition lesson, we require a full term's notice by email to enquiries@hunsleyprimary.org.uk, for which payment must be made. Your child can still continue to receive their music tuition lessons during this notice period. For example, if your child wants to end lessons in the summer term then you must notify us at the beginning of the spring term, otherwise you will be charged for the summer term.
