Re: Hunsley Primary Newsletter

Welcome to the final Newsletter of the school year – I am so pleased to share some fantastic summaries of events and activities the children have been doing in the last couple of weeks.

Today, the **EYFS and KS1** children have been making the most of the slightly cooler weather and getting outside for an **Outdoor Classroom** morning. They are developing great team-building and problem-solving skills, as well as developing confidence and leadership. We love these experiences, as they are great for encouraging friendships too.

Year 6 are out and about for **Bikeability** this week and next. These kinds of activities are possible due to initiatives like the national Sports Premium, supporting active and healthy lifestyles: you may recall that we also took part in scooter and pedestrian training earlier in the year. This Sports Premium is coming to an end this year, but we continue to place real importance on active lifestyles for the children to thrive. You'll also have noticed Year 6 with their **Enterprise Stalls** – no escaping those salesperson skills! Thank you all for supporting them to 'make £5 grow'! Later in the Newsletter, there is a reminder about Monday 13 July – we are opening the gates a little earlier so that parents and carers can visit the children's stalls for House Team fundraising – more below.

Thank you to Logan and Sasch from **Hull FC** who came in on Wednesday to talk to the children about rugby and to run a workshop – this was brilliant! And what a cool day we had (with air conditioning!) at **The Ferens Art Gallery with Year 1** – a pleasure to see them creating still life art at real easels. We have also loved being entertained by **guitar and piano ensemble shows** this week – thank you to everyone who came to watch. The music was lovely!

In other news, **Year 5** are out all day on Monday 6 July, visiting **Spurn Point**. We are glad that the sun is not quite as hot as it has been in the run-up to this visit – more of this further along! Year 2 are gearing up for **Yorkshire Wildlife Park** and **Year 4 for their camping residential**. In all these activities, we are very careful and mindful, as we are in school, of the heat and exposure to the sun.

Important information:

With the above in mind, **as the temperature rises towards the end of the week**, we will continue to apply the DfE and LA guidance for managing the heat, as we have been doing, to keep the children and staff as cool and comfortable as possible. **The children can come in their PE kits all week and – if you wish – until the end of term. Please do make sure it is the school PE kit they are wearing.** We have a few spares if anyone needs any items! All children need water bottles, sunhats and sunscreen on.

Further to a question we have had today, the **school will be open and registering at the usual time on Monday**, as are other local primary schools. We recognise that some of the children's older siblings / family members may be staying up for the football, but we want to make sure that we stick to the children's usual school routine for attendance, for support of our families' routines, consistency for the children and for the provision of planned learning activities and visits, such as the one running to Spurn first thing on Monday morning.

Please make sure your child is in school at the normal time. This includes children who walk, scoot or cycle to school on their own – we really want to make sure they are all safely registered with us at the normal time, as usual. We also want to encourage all our children to be in fully for the next two weeks, to enjoy all the fantastic things we are doing in the last two weeks and fully take part. Thank you for keeping to the usual routines. If your child is a little tired over the coming fortnight, we will always support and help them, as we usually do, to manage their school day.

Thinking of fantastic things our children do, below are the scores on the doors for our recent Sports Day, plus our Games Mark Gold feedback from Amanda Jack, the East Riding SSP lead! Well done, everyone, for being such an active school. We like a bit of competition, so let's see which House Team can win next year!

Your Child's Transition to Hunsley Primary

To ensure a smooth transition to Hunsley Primary, a number of key events will take place between now and your child's first day at school in September. 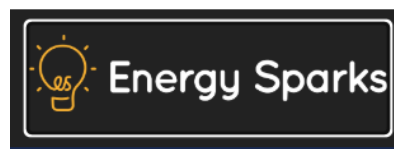

Free School Meal Eligibility changes

From the start of the 2026 to 2027 academic year, the DfE are expanding FSM eligibility to all children from households in receipt of Universal Credit regardless of household earnings. Free school meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

A pupil is only eligible to receive a free school meal where both:

- a claim for this support has been made
- their eligibility has been verified by the school where they are enrolled or by the local authority

Households may also be entitled to a meal if they:

- are in receipt of income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- receive the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- meet criteria set out in separate guidance for [families with no recourse to public funds](#)

Important Information

All current FSM eligibility is to be re-assessed in line with the above criteria by the East Riding of Yorkshire Council. If the claim does not meet the criteria, the ability to claim a free school meal will expire at the end of the current academic year.

The Local Authority will inform families who are no longer eligible.

From 1st September 2026, only families that have the above listed benefits will be eligible.

Early Opening Monday 13 July 2.30pm - Come to school early and visit the children's stalls!

We are fast approaching the dates for our performances and the children are busy with rehearsals!

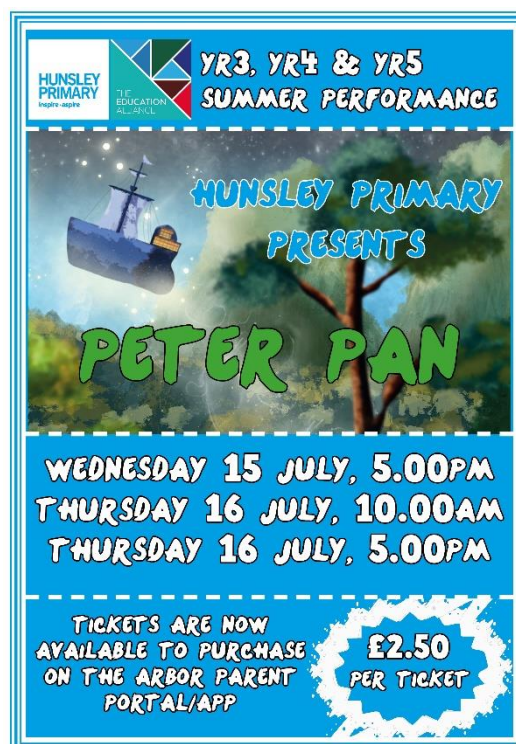

Key Stage 2 SATS results – national delays

I have written to families this week to let you know about a national delay to this year's Key Stage 2 (KS2) SATS results, which affects all schools.

Schools were due to receive the results on 7 July, 2026. However, Pearson Education Limited, the provider responsible for administering, marking, and returning Key Stage 2 results to schools has informed the Department for Education of a delay affecting the national system used to make results available to schools. Results will now be available to schools on 16 July 2026.

This delay will, of course, not impact the general end of term arrangements, and our celebrations of everything the children have achieved over the course of their primary school journey will be unaffected. We look forward to enjoying the last two weeks of term with our Year 6s, looking back and looking onwards to their next steps!

Importantly, the delay is not related to the quality of the tests or the accuracy of pupils' results. Test papers have been marked in line with usual processes.

This will also not impact your child's transition to secondary school and no action is required from parents or pupils. We will share results with you as quickly as possible after we receive them on 16 July.

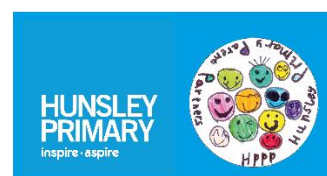
